

# How to borrow and return your books

## Scene 1:

## Scene 2:

Avatar: "To start, click "Loan", the first option, on the screen. Then, scan your Bocconi ID card on the card reader on the right. If you entered the Library using the QR code, you can scan that on the left. Place your books on the self-check surface on the left: you can put more than one at a time. On the screen, you'll see the titles appear: make sure they have all been registered before confirming. When everything's ready, tap "Finished": your checkout is complete. If you'd like, you can send a confirmation receipt directly to your e-mail address."

## Scene 3:

[Screen] On the left side of the screen, there is a video of the same self-check machine. The girl taps the word "Return" that appears on the self-check machine. On the right side of the screen, there is a picture of the self-check machine screen, zoomed in, where the word "Return" is clearly visible and framed in a yellow rectangle. The girl places the books on the book scanner surface on the machine and on the screen the titles of the books appear in green. The girl taps again the button "Finished" on the screen of the machine and then the "No receipt" icon with prohibition sign. The girl takes back the books from the surface and brings them to a return box located on the left side of the machine, with the texts "Library / Biblioteca" and "Book return / Restituzione libri" written on: she inserts them inside the opening of the box. **Avatar:** To return your books it's even easier: click "Return". Then, place the books on the station. Wait until the screen confirms that all items have been checked out. If you'd like, you can send the return confirmation receipt to your e-mail address. After that, put your books into the return box located next to the station.

#### Scene 4:
