

Accessibility Statement

Università Commerciale Luigi Bocconi is committed to making its website accessible, in accordance with Law no. 4 of 9 January 2004. This accessibility statement applies to the institutional website.

Scope

Institutional website: unibocconi.it

Compliance status

Partially compliant

This website is partially compliant with the requirements set out in Appendix A of the UNI CEI EN 301549 standard due to the non-compliance cases listed below:

- *1.1.1 Non-text Content (Level A)*: Some images lack alternative text or use the filename as the description; some icons have technical labels.
- *1.2.2 Captions (Prerecorded) (Level A)*: Videos do not have captions, but only YouTube's automatic captioning.
- *1.2.3 Audio Description or Alternative Media (Prerecorded) (Level A)*: Videos are not accompanied by audio description or an alternative format.
- *1.2.5 Audio Description (Prerecorded) (Level AA)*: Videos are not accompanied by audio description.
- *1.3.5 Identify Input Purpose (Level AA)*: It is not always possible to identify the purpose of input fields.
- *1.4.3 Contrast (Minimum) (Level AA)*: The site's visual design includes elements where text is overlaid on images, creating contrast issues. Alternative design solutions are currently being explored to address this problem. However, the main page text complies with the criterion.
- *2.4.3 Focus Order (Level A)*: Upon closing the "Search Filters" window, the focus does not always return to the correct position. Within the chatbot, focus does not always move correctly within the window.
- *4.1.2 Name, Role, Value (Level A)*: Some controls have incomplete names.

Continuous training is provided for site editors to address issues related to the ongoing addition of new content (such as alt text, titles, and language settings).

Regarding videos, training courses are planned on using integrated audio description techniques wherever possible; alternatively, audio transcripts should be provided.

The *chatbot* on the contact page is not fully accessible, but alternatives such as a contact form or a telephone number are available. Focus does not always shift correctly within the window; however, before the chat opens, a notification informs screen reader users of these limitations.
