## PhD program in Business Administration and Management

## Research interests and Faculty

The PhD program in Business Administration and Management at Bocconi University is a 4-year program in English that offers training in a variety of disciplines related to management studies and emphasizes the skills necessary to integrate different approaches and develop coherent and cutting-edge research. The program provides a collaborative, supportive and intellectually stimulating research environment for discovery and dissemination of scientific knowledge applicable to the business community. Students will develop the theoretical and methodological skills required to participate and publish at the highest standards of the international scientific community.

First-year students acquire a broad set of theoretical and methodological skills relevant to various fields in management studies through a series of common compulsory courses. They also attend courses specific to their curriculum and begin developing their own research. In the second and third year, students will attend a series of elective courses. Starting from the second year, students will more intensively research and progress their dissertations.

Faculty members are leading scholars in their fields. They contribute to the international debate by publishing in and serving the editorial board of research journals, such as: Academy of Management Journal, Strategic Management Journal, Organization Science, Management Science, Academy of Management Review, Journal of Marketing, Journal of Marketing Research, Journal of Consumer Research, Marketing Science, and many others. Visiting professors from top international schools complement the permanent Faculty.
