Programs at the Leading Edge



At Bocconi, you will build a resume at the forefront of today's academic opportunities through a rigorous training program and innovative teaching that fosters critical thinking and socioemotional skills. You will engage closely with outstanding faculty involved in frontier research, as well as guest speakers from the business community, gain exposure to emerging technologies and have the opportunity to take part in a study or work abroad program.

All this with one goal in mind: to ensure a solid and well-rounded education and promote critical thinking, intellectual curiosity and adaptability.

BSc Teaching Structure

While each BSc has its own unique features and profile, all our undergraduate programs are designed to provide a strong academic foundation, foster the development of socioemotional skills and offer a range of opportunities to enrich students' profiles through activities that allow them to personalize their educational path. The first year is devoted to acquiring foundational knowledge. From the second year onwards, specialization courses progressively focus the distinctive content of each degree program. In the third year, elective courses, internships, exchange programs with partner universities and the final project allow students to complete and further strengthen their course of study.

Common Core

All BSc programs in the area of management, finance and economics (BSc in Management, BSc in Management for the Arts and Cultures, BSc in Finance, BSc in Economics and BSc in Management and Computer Science) share a first-year common core. These courses are designed to provide foundational knowledge with an approach that takes into account the impact of cognitive biases and enables students to understand and use the tools offered by artificial intelligence and emerging technologies.

Management

- The program provides students with the tools to understand what resources an organization needs to effectively carry out a project and how those resources should be planned, organized and managed.
 - It examines how companies operate in relation to the various business functions (logistics, marketing, finance, etc.), different types of organizations (commercial, manufacturing, public administration, etc.) and the national and international economic contexts in which they operate.
 - It equips students with analytical methods and tools required to work in continuously evolving environments and to develop an integrated view of the firm and different types of organizations.
 - The program is offered both in Italian and English.
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Management for the Arts and Cultures

- The program focuses on the management of organizations operating in the arts, culture and creative industries, and enables students to acquire the managerial and entrepreneurial skills needed to work in international environments that require adaptability and interaction with different cultures and languages.
 - It offers a solid education in business and management integrated with courses in the humanities.
 - Particular emphasis is placed on project-based learning through group work and workshops.
 - The program is offered entirely in English.
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Finance

- The program enables students to understand how the financial system works, with a focus on capital markets, financial intermediaries, contracts and financial instruments.

- It provides a solid education grounded in rigorous quantitative tools and promotes an analytical, data-driven approach to the assessment of financial decisions and risks.
 - It equips students with the skills needed to operate in domestic and international financial environments that are constantly evolving.
 - The program is offered entirely in English.
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Economics

- The program provides students with the tools to understand the choices of economic agents and how markets function, in order to anticipate the evolution of economic and social phenomena such as growth, employment and inflation, inequality, climate change and globalization, and to assess their impact on national and global markets.
 - It enables students to acquire strong quantitative and methodological skills, together with a broad-based education suited to work in diverse and dynamic national and international settings.
 - It includes two majors:
 - **Major in Economic and Data Sciences**, which explores the application of algorithmic techniques and machine learning to data analysis and the interpretation of economic phenomena.
 - **Major in Economic Sciences**, which combines mathematical models, data analysis and cognitive sciences to understand economic choices and economic and social phenomena.
 - The program is offered entirely in English.
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Management and Computer Science

- The program develops mathematical, statistical and computational skills aimed at training managerial profiles able to leverage the strategic role of data analysis.
- It provides students with the tools to acquire, organize, analyze and interpret data in support of

economic, managerial and financial decision-making in any sector.

- The program is offered entirely in English.

International Politics and Government

- This political science program enables students to interpret the evolution of social, economic and political systems and to understand the decision-making mechanisms of national and international institutions.
- It places particular emphasis on the key stages of policy making: designing public policies that are efficient and politically sustainable, implementing effective public policies and evaluating them through qualitative and quantitative techniques.
- It offers two tracks: the “Politics and Policy Making” track and the “Data, Society and Organisations” track, a Double Degree with HEC Paris. Students interested in the Double Degree with HEC Paris must submit a specific application.
- The program is offered entirely in English.

Mathematical and Computing Sciences for Artificial Intelligence

- This mathematics program is intended for students with strong analytical abilities and a passion for the advancement of science.
- It offers rigorous preparation in several areas of mathematics, computational sciences and modelling techniques from physics in order to understand the modern tools of artificial intelligence, solve quantitative problems and advance AI itself.
- It prepares graduates able to contribute to the advancement of knowledge and applications in artificial intelligence and beyond.
- The program is offered entirely in English.

World Bachelor in Business

- This is a four-year program delivered in partnership with two prestigious international universities: USC (University of Southern California – Marshall School of Business) and HKUST (The Hong Kong University of Science and Technology).
- It offers a distinctive international experience: students spend the first year in Los Angeles, the second in Hong Kong, the third in Milan, and the fourth at one of the three partner institutions of their choice, earning three degrees upon completion of the program.
- The curriculum is focused on the management of international business and is complemented by courses in economics, quantitative methods and law.
- The program is offered entirely in English.
- It has a specific admissions procedure, as well as dedicated tuition fees, scholarships and housing arrangements.



New Frontiers in Law



For more than twenty years, the Bocconi School of Law has been training lawyers and professionals to face the enormous challenges that internationalization, the advent of new technologies and economic development pose to the legal field today. What sets the School's programs apart is that they feature a unique mix of both legal studies and a focus on economics and management.

Our outstanding faculty are engaged in study and research that often involves national and international debate, and we are also part of prestigious international networks bringing together many other leading Law Schools.



Bachelor in Global Law

- The Bachelor in Global Law, taught in English, trains young legal practitioners to carry out innovative legal professions increasingly sought for in the international context of institutions, companies and other organizations.
- You will acquire the theoretical and practical instruments of law and pursue an in-depth study of the global dimension of legal issues, allowing you to work in both international settings and a variety of domestic settings.
- Using teaching methods based on active participation and experiential learning, this program will provide you with a highly interdisciplinary knowledge of law, which combines notions of business management, finance, and economics, as well as training in the use of digital technology.
- It is a program with an international outlook both due to its curriculum, which focuses on a global perspective, and due to its post-graduate opportunities on a global scale. It aims to train graduates with an international background who are interested in an international career.
- After graduation, you will be able to enter the job market at a junior level in the legal field (for example working as data protection officers, legal counsels and transactional lawyers) or continue your studies at graduate level in law, economics, or international relations (for example by doing a JD, MA, MSc or LLM).

In order to apply for admission, you first need to take one of the accepted admissions tests (online Bocconi test, SAT or ACT), and submit your application through the online portal Apply2B.

Programs offered by the School of Law (Global Law and Law) have a dedicated selection process and a different online test. In addition to the tests listed above, the online Bocconi Test - Law and the LSAT are also accepted for these Law programs.

If admitted, you will have about three weeks to confirm your place.

Before applying, please visit the website to check whether you qualify as an Italian or international applicant, and follow the application procedures and deadlines for your category.



TIMELINE FOR INTERNATIONAL APPLICANTS

Online Bocconi Test

The online Bocconi Test and the online Bocconi Test - Law can be taken on a variety of different dates using a dedicated platform.

From 15 July 2026 to 21 January 2027

Each of the two types of test can be taken a maximum of four times during this period.

Fees and Funding

Bocconi tuition and fees will be **approximately € 17,000** per year in **the 2027-2028 academic year**.

The tuition is divided into different installments that students pay throughout the year.

Bocconi has always been committed to making higher education available to all motivated and talented students through a financial aid system, based on both merit and need.

The “**Bocconi4Access to Education**” support scheme aims to promote access to a pluralistic environment and an open and accessible university. The University's financial investment is therefore tailored to the **economic backgrounds** of students' families, and offers different funding options:

- Bocconi Access to Education Scholarships: a 100%, 80% or 60% tuition waiver for students in challenging and potentially constraining economic family conditions
- Boost Your Future Scholarships: a 40% or 20% partial tuition waiver for students who, even with their family support, still require significant assistance in addition to their family's investment
- Women Awards: for women admitted to specific programs

Enrolled students may also apply for an **ISU Bocconi Scholarship** or for contributions for participation in **international mobility** and **internship** programs.

Furthermore, different **loan** opportunities are available for EU and US citizens (e.g. FAFSA).

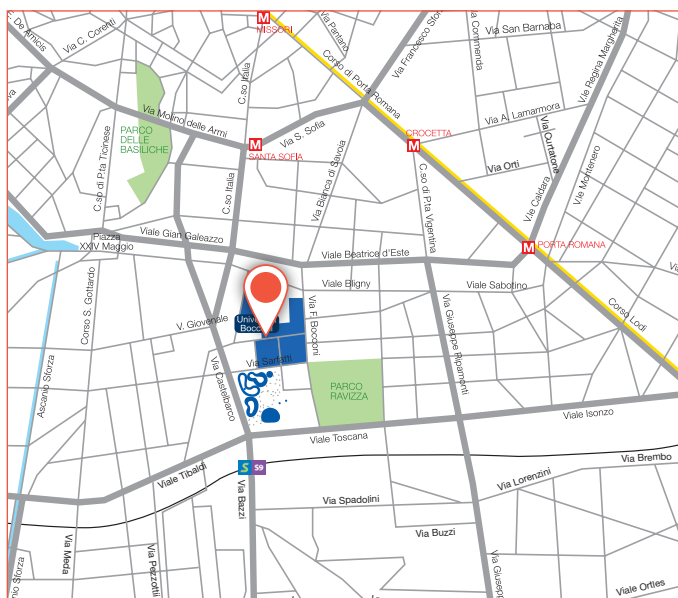
