The Università Commerciale "Luigi Bocconi", with registered office in Via Sarfatti 25, Milan, as "Data Controller" (hereinafter referred to as "Bocconi" or "University"), informs you that the data you provide will be processed in compliance with the legislation on the protection of personal data (EU Regulation 2016/679, "GDPR"), and D. Lgs. 196/2003 and ss.mm.ii., ("Privacy Code").

Data Protection Officer

Methods of data processing

Personal data are processed by manual, computerised and telematic means in accordance with the stated purposes, in such a way as to guarantee the security and confidentiality of the data, in addition to compliance with the specific obligations laid down by law. No automated decision-making process will be used during the processing operations.

Recipients of personal data

For the pursuit of the above-mentioned purposes, the personal data collected may be communicated to

- internal units within the University (teaching secretariat, lecturers, departments, academic bodies, commissions) by staff authorised to process data, in accordance with Article 29 of the GDPR and Article 2-quaterdecies of the Privacy Code, because of the performance of their work duties;
- third-party companies (e.g. IT and/or web service providers), as data processors, specifically appointed pursuant to Article 28 of the GDPR;
- competent medical staff, who will process the personal data collected independently, for the pursuit of their own purposes.



Data transfer outside the EU

Personal data collected will in no way be transferred to non-EU countries or international organisations; it will be processed only in Italy.

The rights of the data subject

You have the right to access your data at any time, pursuant to Articles 15-22 of the GDPR. In particular, as a data subject, you have:

- a. the right to obtain confirmation as to whether or not personal data concerning him or her are being processed and, if so, to obtain access to them (Art. 15);
- b. the right to obtain the updating and/or rectification/supplementation of your personal data (Art. 16);
- c. the right to obtain the deletion of one's personal data, in cases where this is permitted by the GDPR (Art. 17);
- d. the right to obtain the restriction of the processing of one's personal data if one of the hypotheses provided for by the legislation in force (Art. 18) applies;
- e. for non-compulsory data processing that finds its legal basis in consent, the right to revoke consent, without prejudice to the lawfulness of the processing carried out before revocation;
- f. the right to receive, in a structured, commonly used and machine-readable format, personal data concerning you that you have provided to the Data Controller and you have the right to transmit such data to another Data Controller without hindrance from the Data Controller to whom you have provided them if i) the processing is based on consent pursuant to Art. 6(1)(a) or 9(2)(a), or on a contract within the meaning of Article 6(1)(b); and the processing is carried out by automated means (Art. 20).

As a data subject, you also have the right to object at any time to the processing of your personal data carried out for the purposes indicated in paragraph 3(d).

Without prejudice to any other administrative or jurisdictional recourse, you also have the right to lodge a complaint (Art. 77 GDPR) with the Privacy Authority (www.garanteprivacy.it), if you believe that the processing of your personal data violates the applicable data protection regulations.

To exercise all of the above rights, you may reach the Data Controller or the DPO in writing at the above-mentioned addresses.
