Dear data subject,

We would like to inform you that, pursuant to Article 13 of EU Regulation No. 2016/679 (hereinafter, "GDPR"), your personal data will be processed by electronic and manual means, in Italy and abroad. This Privacy Policy, provided on the basis of the principle of transparency and all the elements required by the GDPR, is divided into individual sections, each of which deals with a specific topic in order to make the reading quicker, easier and easier to understand (hereinafter, the "Information Notice").

1. Data controller

The data controller is the Università Commerciale "Luigi Bocconi", with registered office in Via Sarfatti 25 - Milan (hereinafter the "Data Controller").

2. Purpose of processing

Your personal data will be processed for the purpose of registering on the JobGate portal (hereinafter referred to as the "Portal") in order to allow you to navigate on the Portal and to benefit from the services provided.

3. Personal data processed

The Data Controller will process, for the purposes indicated, your first name, last name, email address, and the role you hold within the relevant company. Failure to provide this personal data, or providing it in part or inexactly, will make it impossible for the Controller to allow you to use the services on the Portal

4. Legal basis for processing

The legal basis for the processing of your personal data is the provision of the service via the Portal, pursuant to Article 6(b) of the GDPR.



5. Communication, dissemination of data and territorial scope of processing

Your personal data will be processed exclusively:

- by persons authorised to process them, pursuant to and for the purposes of Article 29 GDPR;
- by persons designated as Data Processors in accordance with Article 28 of the GDPR, such as third-party companies carrying out activities on behalf of the Controller.

Your personal data will be processed by the Controller within and outside the territory of the European Union. The transfer of your personal data to entities located outside the European Union will be regulated in accordance with the GDPR. All necessary precautions will be taken to ensure full protection of your personal data by basing such transfer on the evaluation of appropriate safeguards.

In any case, you may obtain further details from the Data Controller by requesting evidence of the specific guarantees adopted.

6. Data retention period

The personal data referred to in point 3 will be processed by the Controller until they are deleted from the Portal.

7. Rights of the data subject

Pursuant to Articles 15 et seq. of the GDPR, you may, at any time, exercise the rights expressly granted to you and in particular obtain:

- confirmation as to whether or not personal data relating to you are being processed. concern and to obtain access to the data and the following information (purpose of processing, categories of personal data, recipients and/or categories of recipients to whom the data have been and/or will be disclosed, storage period);
- the rectification of inaccurate personal data concerning you and/or the integration of incomplete personal data, including by providing a supplementary declaration;
- the deletion of personal data, in the cases provided for by the GDPR;



- the restriction of processing in the cases provided for by the privacy legislation in force;
- the portability of your data and/or request the direct transmission of your data to another data controller;
- objection to the processing of your personal data at any time, for reasons related to your particular situation, in full compliance with current privacy legislation, as well as for marketing and profiling purposes.

In any case, you will always have the right to lodge a complaint with the competent supervisory authority (Garante per la Protezione dei Dati Personali), pursuant to Article 77 GDPR, if you believe that the processing of your data is contrary to the privacy legislation in force.
