The Judging Committee of the competition by exam and academic titles for 2 spots for a Research Grant related to sector 13/A1 Economic Policy with a duration of two year at the Baffi Carefin Centre of Università Commerciale "Luigi Bocconi" of Milan is made up of:

The Committee took note of the regulations set out in the notice of competition that the maximum points to be assigned are as follows:

- 30 points out of 100 for the evaluation of CV, academic titles and research and programming experience;
  - 30 points out of 100 for the evaluation of scientific publications presented and the "Document to pursue the research";
  - 40 points out of 100 for the evaluation by interview.

- 100 points out of a total of 100

Only candidates who achieve a minimum of 40 points in the evaluation of titles, publications and project will be admitted to be evaluated by interview.
