## PhD program in Social and Political Science

## Research interests and Faculty

The **PhD** in Social and Political Science at Bocconi University is a rigorous and innovative four-year, full-time program designed to train highly motivated scholars for successful careers in academia, research, and policy. The program offers advanced training across political economy, political science, demography, public management and administration, and sociology, equipping graduates with the skills and experience needed to compete at the highest international level.

Open to outstanding students with a strong aptitude and passion for research, the program combines solid methodological foundations with the flexibility to specialize in one of several fields through a wide range of elective courses.

In the first two years, students acquire state-of-the-art theoretical and methodological tools that inform their specialization. By the end of the second year, they produce an original research paper under the guidance of faculty mentors, ensuring early engagement with independent research. The third and fourth years are devoted to dissertation work, allowing students to develop ambitious projects that make a significant scholarly contribution.

Beyond coursework and research, students benefit from a dynamic intellectual environment. They engage with world-class faculty and visiting scholars, participate in seminars and workshops, and present their work in front of international audiences. The program also supports exchanges and research internships with leading universities and policy institutes worldwide, providing students with invaluable professional networks and experience.

Graduates of Bocconi's PhD in Social and Political Science are exceptionally well prepared for the academic and research job market. With rigorous training, close faculty mentorship, and strong institutional support, they enter the next stage of their careers ready to contribute to cutting-edge scholarship and to address the pressing social and political challenges of our time.

The Faculty are world leaders in their respective research fields and hold key positions in both research and policy development. In addition to publishing in top academic journals, many faculty members are actively involved as editors for renowned international journals or work as consultants with global organizations. They have a strong track record of receiving prestigious research grants, including awards from institutions like the European Research Council and the National Science Foundation in the United States.

The PhD program is designed to prepare and foster careers either in leading academic institutions or in international think tanks; sub-, national, and supra-national governmental organizations; NGOs; and the private sector.
