

## COMPETITION BY EXAM AND ACADEMIC TITLES, ANNOUNCED ON 17/06/2020 PROT. N. 25465 FOR THE CONFERRAL OF 1 RESEARCH GRANT WITH A DURATION OF 12 MONTHS FOR THE SECTOR 13/A4 – APPLIED ECONOMICS AT THE DEPARTMENT OF MANAGEMENT AND TECHNOLOGY OF UNIVERSITÀ COMMERCIALE "LUIGI BOCCONI" OF MILAN

### Minutes 1

The Judging Committee of the competition by exam and academic titles for 1 spot for a Research Grant related to sector 13/A4 – Applied Economics with a duration of 12 months at the Department of Management and Technology of Università Commerciale "Luigi Bocconi" of Milan is made up of:

- Prof. Franco Malerba, Full Professor
- Prof. Stefano Breschi, Full Professor
- Prof. Nicoletta Corrocher, Lecturer

It met on June 21<sup>st</sup> 2020 at 9 am online to decide the scores to assign to the research and academic titles and publications.

The Committee had appointed Prof. Franco Malerba as President and Prof. Nicoletta Corrocher as Secretary.

The Committee took note of the regulations set out in the notice of competition that the maximum points to be assigned are as follows:

- 30 points out of 100 for the evaluation of CV, academic titles and research and programming experience;
  - 30 points out of 100 for the evaluation of scientific publications presented and the "Document to pursue the research";
  - 40 points out of 100 for the evaluation by interview.

- 100 points out of a total of 100

Only candidates who achieve a minimum of 45 points in the evaluation of titles, publications and project will be admitted to be evaluated by interview.

Having read the applications and titles submitted by the candidates of the competition, which were all compliant with what was set out in the competition notice, the following points were assigned:

Evaluation of CV, academic titles and research and programming experience	25 points

Evaluation of scientific publications and the "Document to pursue the research";	25 points
<b>TOTAL</b>	<b>50 points</b>

The candidate presents a very good curriculum in terms of academic qualifications. The publications are of a very good level, although very focused on green innovation, energy and environment and therefore not in line with the research topics related to the research grant.

LUCA GALLORINI	
Evaluation of CV, academic titles and research and programming experience	15 points
Evaluation of scientific publications and the "Document to pursue the research";	5 points
<b>TOTAL</b>	<b>20 points</b>

The candidate presents a satisfactory curriculum from the point of view of academic titles, although without relevant research experience, while there is no evidence of scientific publications, except for a draft of a paper on the role of trademarks for business strategies.

SHAIMA' SALEM A. MOH'D	
Evaluation of CV, academic titles and research and programming experience	20 points
Evaluation of scientific publications and the "Document to pursue the research";	20 points
<b>TOTAL</b>	<b>40 points</b>

The candidate has a good cv. She has published one paper in a scientific journal (Project Management Journal) and two are under review, while the rest of the submitted publications are conference proceedings/papers. The publications deal with topics that are very different from those related to the research grant.

<b>IRENA MNATSAKANYAN</b>	
Evaluation of CV, academic titles and research and programming experience	20 points
Evaluation of scientific publications and the "Document to pursue the research";	15 points
<b>TOTAL</b>	<b>35 points</b>

The candidate has a good curriculum and good project management experience mainly developed in Armenia. The publications submitted (two of them in Armenian) are not relevant for the research grant project.

<b>SILVIO TRAVERSO</b>	
Evaluation of CV, academic titles and research and programming experience	25 points
Evaluation of scientific publications and the "Document to pursue the research";	25 points
<b>TOTAL</b>	<b>50 points</b>

The candidate presents a very good curriculum in terms of academic qualifications. The publications are also of a very good level, even if they deal with topics very different from those related to the research grant.

<b>ALIASGHAR BAHOO TORODI</b>	
Evaluation of CV, academic titles and research and programming experience	30 points
Evaluation of scientific publications and the "Document to pursue the research";	30 points
<b>TOTAL</b>	<b>60 points</b>

The candidate presents an excellent curriculum, both in terms of academic and scientific titles. The publications are also of excellent level and perfectly in line with the themes of the project related to the research grant.

MARIELLA VITANTONIO	
Evaluation of CV, academic titles and research and programming experience	15 points
Evaluation of scientific publications and the "Document to pursue the research";	10 points
<b>TOTAL</b>	<b>35 points</b>

The candidate has a satisfactory curriculum in terms of academic qualifications, even if she lacks a solid research experience. She has one publication on a topic which is different from those of the research grant project.
