Minutes n. 2 - Teaching exam and overall evaluations

On Wednesday, 29 June 2022 at 12:00 pm, it met via an online call, convened by prof. Pierpaolo Battigalli, Director of the Department of Decision Sciences, The Committee in charge of the comparative evaluation for the conferral of n. 1 fixed-term private law contract as "Lecturer", announced by the Luigi Bocconi University on April 22nd 2022, prot. n. 4594, for the competition sector 13/D4., via an online call, on June 13th 2022 at 11:00 am.

The candidates admitted to the trial academic lesson:

Dr Fabio Tonoli, summoned at 12:00 pm

At 12:00 pm the candidate Dr Fabio Tonoli is present and starts the teaching exam in English, invited accordingly of the evaluation of qualifications held in the meeting on 13/06/2022 at 11:00 am.

In the meeting with Faculty and Staff Administration (Recruiting Office) of Bocconi University on 28 June at 12:00 pm, as in art. 4 of the Call for applications, 5 teaching topics were proposed to the candidate in a close envelope:

- 1. Convex sets and functions
- 2. Vector spaces
- 3. Linear Programming: the simplex method
- 4. Integration
- Probability, conditional probability and Bayes' Theorem

The candidate randomly drew envelopes 1,2, and 4 and chose a topic:

Convex sets and functions



The Committee, after the exam, formulates the following final opinion:

"The candidate has presented a clear and accurate lecture on the subject of convexity. He has started with the definition of convex sets and has continued describing the main aspects of convexity for functions.

He used clear examples, common language and very clear graphical displays. In the final question period, Prof. Cerreia Vioglio, after a positive comment on the lecture, mentioned the importance of convexity in economic choice and consumer choice theory. Prof. Battigalli also expressed a positive impression about the lecture and noted the possibility of further connecting the notion of convexity with that of the epigraph of a function. The overall committee's evaluation is very positive".

Based on this evaluation, after a discussion, the Committee unanimously proposes to assign the Lecturer contract lasting 3 years (renewable) at the Decision Sciences Department to:

The contract starts: September 2022 1st 2022
