The Judging Committee of the competition by exam and academic titles for 1 spot for a Research Grant related to sector 13/A5 ECONOMETRICS (*Scientific Sector SECS-P/05 Econometrics*) with a duration of one year at Baffi Carefin Centre of Università Commerciale "Luigi Bocconi" in Milan is made up of:

It met via conference call on Friday 5 June 2020 at 3:00pm to decide the scores to assign to the research and academic titles and publications.

The Committee had appointed Prof. Massimo Guidolin as President and Prof. Paolo Colla as Secretary.

The Committee took note of the regulations set out in the notice of competition that the maximum points to be assigned are as follows:

- 30 points out of 100 for the evaluation of CV, academic titles and research and programming experience;
 - 30 points out of 100 for the evaluation of scientific publications presented and the "Document to pursue the research";
 - 40 points out of 100 for the evaluation by interview.

Only candidates who achieve a minimum of 40 points in the evaluation of titles, publications and project will be admitted to be evaluated by interview.

Having read the applications and titles submitted by the candidates of the competition, which were all compliant with what was set out in the competition notice, the following points were assigned:
