The Judging Committee of the competition by exam and academic titles for 1 spot for a Research Grant related to sector 13/A4 Applied Economics (Economia Applicata) with a duration of 2 years at the GREEN research center Università Commerciale "Luigi Bocconi" of Milan is made up of:

- Prof. Michele Polo, Full Professor
- Prof. Alberto Bramanti, Associate Professor
- Prof Marco Percoco, Associate Professor

It met on June 23rd at 3 pm via conference call to decide the scores to assign to the research and academic titles and publications.

The Committee had appointed Prof. Michele Polo as President and Prof. Marco Percoco as Secretary.

The Committee took note of the regulations set out in the notice of competition that the maximum points to be assigned are as follows:

- 30 points out of 100 for the evaluation of CV, academic titles and research and programming experience;
- 30 points out of 100 for the evaluation of scientific publications presented and the "Document to pursue the research";
- 40 points out of 100 for the evaluation by interview.

- 100 points out of a total of 100

Only candidates who achieve a minimum of 40 points in the evaluation of titles, publications and project will be admitted to be evaluated by interview.

Having read the applications and titles submitted by the candidates of the competition, which were all compliant with what was set out in the competition notice, the following points were assigned:

Borsati's CV is strongly coherent with the research program; he also has several international experiences in primary institutions. Borsati has also two publications in top field journals.

Dr Chakraborty has an interesting CV, but not in line with the skills needed to carry out the research program. He has limited international research experiences and publications are good, but not coherent with transportation economics.

Dr Giacobbe has a good CV with several international experiences, even though it is not in line with the research program. The candidate does not have publications, but he presents some working papers but on a topic different from economics of transportation.
