MINUTES

The evaluation committee composed of Prof. Nicola Gennaioli (President), Prof. Guido Tabellini (Principal Investigator) and Prof. Nicola Pavoni (Secretary), nominated on 09 Jan. 2020, prot. n.116 met on 09 Jan 2020 at 4:00PM.

We received N.1 applications:

- SERGIO CAPPELLINI

According to the regulations of the competition, the Committee has concluded that the maximum scores to be allocated are as follows:

- 40 points out of of 100 for the evaluation of the CV, qualifications and publications¹
- 60 points out of 100 for the evaluation of the interview²

Only those candidates who achieve a score of at least 30 points for the evaluation of the CV, qualifications and publications will be invited to interview.

Having evaluated the applications submitted, the Commission has allocated the following scores:

According to the criteria listed in the advertisement, the candidate Sergio Cappellini has been admitted to the interview that will take place on Jan, 13, 2020 at 4:00pm.

The Committee confirms that the interview of the candidate Sergio Cappellini took place on Jan 13, 2020 at 4:00pm in room n.5-e1-08, in via Roentgen 1, Milan. The Commission asked the candidate Sergo Cappellini a set of questions relating to his CV and about the main themes of the project indicated in the call. At the end of the interview, and upon the departure of the candidate, the Committee, unanimously expressed a positive evaluation and assigned him a score of 45 points.

Therefore, the total points allocated to the candidate are 36+45=81.

The Committee agreed that the candidate **SERGIO CAPPELLINI** is suitable to cover the offered position.
