Part of his new approach is to include people who are not exactly normal, like dwarves or bearded ladies. This new more freakish angle of his circus begins to attract more people. His ride to success is a bit bumpy at first, but in the end he and his family become fabulously rich and are accepted in New York society. P. T. Barnum is still known as the most circus that ever existed.
