

MINUTES OF THE SELECTION COMMITTEE MEETING OF THE COMPETITION FOR THE CONFERRAL OF N. 1 PRIVATE LAW CONTRACT OF A FIXED-TERM "LECTURER" FOR THE COMPETITION SECTOR 13 / C1 ECONOMIC HISTORY AT THE DEPARTMENT OF "SOCIAL SCIENCES AND POLITICS" OF THE LUIGI BOCCONI UNIVERSITY OF MILAN

Minutes n. 1

The Committee meeting, convened by prof. Andrea Colli, Director of the Department of Social and Political Sciences, was held on Monday 21 June 2021 at 10.00 am.

The Committee is in charge of the comparative evaluation for the conferral of n. 1 fixed-term private law contract as "Lecturer", announced by the Luigi Bocconi University on May 18, 2021, prot. n. 15095, for the competition sector 13 / C1 ECONOMIC HISTORY, for the evaluation of the applications received and the identification of candidates to be admitted to a trial academic lesson.

The Committee is composed as follows:

- Prof. Andrea Colli President
- Prof. Alessia Melegaro Committee member
- Prof. Guido Alfani Secretary

The Committee takes note that n. 3 applications have been duly submitted. The applications have been analyzed based on the criteria expressed in the competition announcement. In order to possibly invite candidates to attend an academic lesson to conclude the comparative assessment, the curricula, the list of publications and the qualifications presented by each candidate were preliminarily evaluated.

The teaching profile required by the announcement regards courses concerning the grouping of "Economic History". In particular, in light of the educational needs expressed by the Department of Social and Political Sciences, the Committee takes in special account the issues of Economic History from the Middle Ages to the present with particular attention to Business History, to be delivered in Italian and English languages, and the areas characterizing the candidates disciplinary interests, skills and teaching. The Committee also considers that having significant teaching experience is important for a position of this kind.

Based on this evaluation, the Committee formulates the following judgments:

- Riccardo Marchingiglio, born in Erice, il 17/12/1990.

Judgment: The candidate holds a PhD in Economics at Northwestern University (2020). His teaching experience is mainly in the field of economics. He has been teaching assistant in courses of Quantitative Methods II (PhD), People Analytics and Strategy (MBA), Analytics for Strategy, Applied Econometrics, Western Economic History, Economics of Inequality and Discrimination, Economics of Education, Economics of Inequality and Discrimination. He is also author and co-author of two papers about the economics of education, based on the analysis of long-term series.

The Committee appreciates the curriculum and the research efforts of the candidate, but does not consider him enough qualified for the position on the ground of the following:

a) a very limited teaching experience in the field of the call, with only one year experience as a teaching assistant

b) The experience is limited to that of teaching assistance to a course in Western Economic History, which is not enough for the global approach of the economic and business history courses taught at Bocconi.

b) no experience at all in the field of Business History courses, in which a significant portion of teaching is due.

The candidate seems to be instead very much qualified for undertaking teaching/research related positions in the field of economics and econometrics.

- Marina Nicoli, born in Lodi il 27/10/1980.

Judgment: The candidate holds a PhD in Economic and Social History (2008). She has been teaching economic and business history courses since 2007. She is also author of several teaching materials and has been the course responsible of economic and business history classes during the last academic years. She is also active at the national and international level in the main associations of the field, and has been involved in several teaching improvement projects. She is also editor and author of books, articles and book chapters in the field of economic and business history. Her teaching evaluations over the last years, made available to the committee, are impeccable. Overall, the Committee considers Marina Nicoli as qualified for the position of the call on the ground of the following:

a) a long-standing experience in teaching as course coordinator over the last years in courses of economic and business history

b) a solid experience in research and academic activity in the field

c) a consistent expertise in the production of teaching materials in the field of the call

- Salman Bahoo, born in Pakistan, il 05/04/1987.

Judgment: The candidate holds a PhD in International Business at University of Agder (Norway) and Managerial and Actuarial Sciences (University of Udine) – in a joint agreement. He is currently a postdoctoral researcher at Università Politecnica delle Marche (Ancona). He has teaching experience as assistant in courses of International Business, Management, Business Strategy, Foundation of Business, Firm Strategy, Globalization Strategy, Financial Management, International Finance, Business Finance. He is author of papers in the field of international business. The Committee appreciates the candidate's CV but does not

think he is qualified for the position of the call, on the ground of the following reasons:




a) no competences or expertise in teaching and in research in the field of economic and business history.
