



ANTIN IP ASSOCIATE PROFESSORSHIP IN INFRASTRUCTURE FINANCE DISRUPTION IN THE INFRASTRUCTURE SECTOR IMPLICATIONS FOR INVESTORS AND ASSET MANAGERS

A number of dramatic changes are reshaping infrastructure, a sector that has always been considered as a safe harbor by investors and asset managers in the field of alternative investments. A combination of renewed attention to environmental impact and ESG, the world population dynamics and urbanization trends, the impact of the digital revolution all have reshaped the characteristics of the infrastructure sector and pose important questions to investors and asset managers working in this field of finance. The understanding of how new ecosystems work and how investors can adapt their strategies to the new investment environment are key success factors for long term investment strategies.

The event presents the results of the first year of a five year research plan carried out under the Antin IP Associate Professorship in Infrastructure Finance and discusses the effects of disruption on the infrastructure sector with a qualified panel of professionals to understand how to prepare for the unexpected.
