#### Introduction

The course, which lasts 40 hours, is aimed at beginners and intends to provide the basic elements of spoken and written language and preparation for the HSK level 1 equivalent to A1 certification.

The activity is proposed in the first and second semester of the academic year: the student receives information on the enrolment procedure and period through the yoU@B diary. At the end of this period, a message is sent with regards to admission / non-admission to the course.

A certificate of participation will be issued upon attending 75% of the hours of the course.



## Program

The program includes an introductory lesson, cultural lessons, a simulation of the HSK 1st level exam and the development of the units 1 to 7 of the textbook used, which can be summarized as follows:

- · Grammatical and syntactic elements
- Analysis of Chinese characters (hanzi), phonetic transcription (pinyin)
- Writing and phonetics exercises
- Reading and understanding of appropriate text
- Conversations in Chinese language
