PRIVACY INFORMATION (articles13 and 14, EU Regulation 679/2016 GDPR)

Pursuant to EU Regulation 679/2016 ("GDPR"), BOCCONI SPORT TEAM SOCIETA' SPORTIVA DILETTANTISTICA a.r.l., (hereinafter "Data Controller") provides the following information regarding the processing of the personal data provided.

1. Data Controller Identity and Contact Information

2. Purpose of Processing and Legal Basis of Processing

Personal data will be processed for aims directly connected to and instruments for the provision of the services requested, specifically:

A) managing registration and participation in activities at our facilities (you will be requested for: ordinary personal data and special personal data – specifically health data – gathered for the purposes of finalizing registration and potentially completing the schedule/program related to activities in the weight room);

B) insurance and institutional purposes (managing relations with sports federations and

organizations promoting sports with which the Data Controller is affiliated);

C) managing payments and issuing related receipts and/or invoices;

D) <u>sending communications (by email and/or phone) related to the management/organization of activities held at our facility.</u>

In order to complete registration in our activities, our assigned staff will also know special data ("sensitive" data), specifically **health data**, included in a medical certificate proving the state of physical fitness and/or data you communicated.

Personal data is processed lawfully, where processing is required to fulfil the obligations to which the Data Controller is subject and/or fulfil a specific request of the Data Subject (specifically, request for registration in activities of the Data Controller).

<u>Sending communications (letter D) is subject to explicit consent expressed by signing for acceptance.</u>

3. Optional or Required Nature of Processing

Failure to communicate personal data shall prevent the completion of registration in the sports activities managed and/or organized by the undersigned. Granting of personal data, including special data related to the state of health, is required.

The granting of data for the purposes of sending communications not included in the normal management of your registration is not required, but failure to consent to the use of such data for the abovementioned purposes will prevent you from staying informed regarding the activities and initiatives promoted and/or organized by the undersigned.

4. Storage of Data

Data shall be stored for a period of time no longer than that required for the purposes for which it was gathered and in any case while the Member is "active" or subsequently processed in compliance with what is set out in legal requirements.

Data gathered for the aims indicated in section 2 letter D) shall be processed until an explicit cancellation request has been received.

5. Recipients of Personal Data

Where required for the aims described in section 2, data may be also be communicated to third parties.

Specifically:

- Sports federations and organizations promoting sports with which the Data Controller is affiliated;
- Professional instructors/collaborators linked to the Data Controller who perform activities that are complementary to the Data Controller's activities;
- Companies that are contractually linked to the Data Controller who, as an example, may perform consulting activities, support services, etc.;
- Administrative or judicial authorities, to comply with legal requirements;

6. Transfer of Data

Data granted shall not be transferred in Member States of the European Union or in third countries that are not part of the EU.

7. Data Subject's Rights

At any time, you may exercise all the rights recognized by applicable internal and European regulations, in particular articles 13, 14, 15-23 and 34 of the European Regulation and the national regulations in force, with a written request sent by registered mail or email to the contacts indicated in section 1 to the Data Controller identified above. In particular:

- a) *Right to access:* the right to obtain a confirmation from the Data Controller whether or not personal data is being processed, access to data and special information (aims of use, categories of personal data in question, recipients and categories of recipients to whom the personal data was or will be communicated, estimated period of storage);
- b) Right to correct and delete: the right to correct incorrect personal data, add to incomplete personal data, delete personal data if personal data is no longer required for the aims for which it was gathered and processed; if data is processed unlawfully; if consent was revoked;
- c) *Right to object and revoke:* the right to object in full or in part to processing of personal data even if pertaining to the aims of gathering data for legitimate reasons, or revoke, in full or in part, your consent, when required.
- d) *Right to limitation:* the right to obtain from the Data Controller a limitation of use, in cases in which the accuracy of personal data is challenged (for the period required for the Data Controller to verify the accuracy of such personal data), if processing is illicit and/or the Data Subject is opposed to processing;
- e) Right to data portability: the right to receive personal data in a customary, structured format that can be read by an automatic device and to transfer such data to another Data Controller, only in cases in which processing is based on consent and only for data processed using electronic instruments;
- f) The right to file a claim with a supervisory authority (Data Protection Officer) or judicial authorities;

Please note that the Data Controller shall not use any processing aimed at an automated decision making process, including data profiling, as stated in article 22 of the EU2016/679 Regulation.
